**Buffalo Transportation & Pierce Arrow Museum (1)** featuring Pierce Arrow Thomas Flyer and Buffalo made automobiles, bicycles, trucks, memorabilia etc. Wed-Sun.12-5 263 Michigan - 2 blocks from station [www.pierce-arrow.com](http://www.pierce-arrow.com)

**Dunn Tire Park (2)** directly across the street from the Buffalo/Exchange St. station. Home of the Buffalo Bisons baseball team, the Triple A team of the Cleveland Indians.



**Buffalo & Erie County Naval & Military Park (3)** Tour the decks and hulls of a guided missile cruiser and destroyer. On Buffalo waterfront - 6 blocks from the station. Daily April - October 10-5, Nov.- Sat. & Sun. 716- 847-1773 [www.buffalonaivalpark.org](http://www.buffalonaivalpark.org)



**Miss Buffalo & Niagara Clipper Cruises (4)** Pass through the historic Black Rock Lock & Canal, see Buffalo's original 1833 lighthouse, and Fort Erie. Enjoy delicious dining and entertainment. **Albright-Knox Art Gallery (6)** cited as "one of the world's top international surveys of contemporary paintings and sculpture" and is especially rich in American and European art of the past 50 years. 1285 Elmwood Ave. Take the #20 Bus, located 5 blocks from station at Washington & N. **Buffalo Museum of Science (7)** Collection covers the spectrum from anthropology to zoology. Tue-Sun 1020 Humbolt Parkway 716-896-5200 Metro Rail to Summer, then bus #22 [www.sciencebuff.org](http://www.sciencebuff.org)

**Metro Rail (8)** (2 blocks from station) takes you to the Main St. Theater District with the restored **Shea's Performing Arts Theater (9)** and Chippewa St. - Restaurants, jazz, music clubs, etc.

**Other Attractions:** Buffalo/Erie County Historical Society Museum (including Pan-American Exposition), HSBC Arena, Buffalo Zoological Gardens, Historic Allentown, Burchfield-Penney Art Center, African-American Cultural Center, Lower Lakes Marine Historical Society Museum.
