Center at High Falls (1) in Brown's Race Historic District – An educational and a entertainment complex. Interactive 3-D exhibits, art gallery. Triphammer Forge, the ruins of an 1816 factory. Laser, Light & Fireworks Spectacular May – October
Stunning view from the Pedestrian Bridge of the 96-foot water falls. Restaurants.

Frontier Field (2) – Home of the Triple-A Rochester Red Wings, an affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Six blocks from the station, just past Brown's Race Historic District.

Strong Museum (6) a variety of interactive learning environments, Including "Sesame Street" where visitors can appear on a TV screen with characters from the show. collections include Dollhouses, toys, miniatures, working 1918 carousel.
