

## Fun “One-Day Trip” to: **Syracuse NY**

Relax and enjoy the scenery as you travel to Syracuse from your nearest Amtrak station. Enjoy salads, deli sandwiches, snacks and beverages in the café car while in route. Amtrak offers a 15% senior discount, children 2-15 travel for half-fare.

**Map Location:**

**Syracuse Regional Transportation Center (1)** just three blocks from the **Carousel Center** and adjacent to the **P&C Stadium** – home of the Syracuse Triple A SkyChiefs. Transportation Center has tourist and bus information desk, sub and donut shop.



**Carousel Center (2)** features over 170 stores, 18 restaurants, 19-screen cinema and a fully restored 1909 antique carousel (just two blocks from the Amtrak station). For Carousel Center events & information – [www.carousel.com](http://www.carousel.com) or 315-466-7000



**Armory Square Historic District (3)** easily accessible from the Carousel Mall by On-Track’s RDC Budd Car. Armory Square offers galleries, quaint shops, music, clubs, restaurants and Museum of Science & Technology. On-Track operates Wed-Sun. (Fri. Sat. Sun in June/July/August)

**Museum of Science & Technology (4)** No matter what age –touching, turning, pushing and experimenting with all the interactive exhibits and activities. Also, the Silverman Planetarium offers daily sky shows. In Armory Square 315-425- 9068



**Erie Canal Museum (5)** our the National Register Landmark Weighblock Building, restored to its 1850 appearance with 65-foot canal boat and education gallery filled with interactive exhibits. Daily at 318 Erie Blvd. 315-471-0593

**Everson Museum of Art (6)** primary collections of 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century American art, paintings, sculptures, ceramics, prints, and watercolors. Tue-Sat. at 401 Harrison St. 315-474-6064



**Museum of Automobile History (7)** Takes visitors on a ride through history with more than 10,000 displays of automobile memorabilia. Wed.-Sun. at 321 N. Clinton St. 315-478-2277

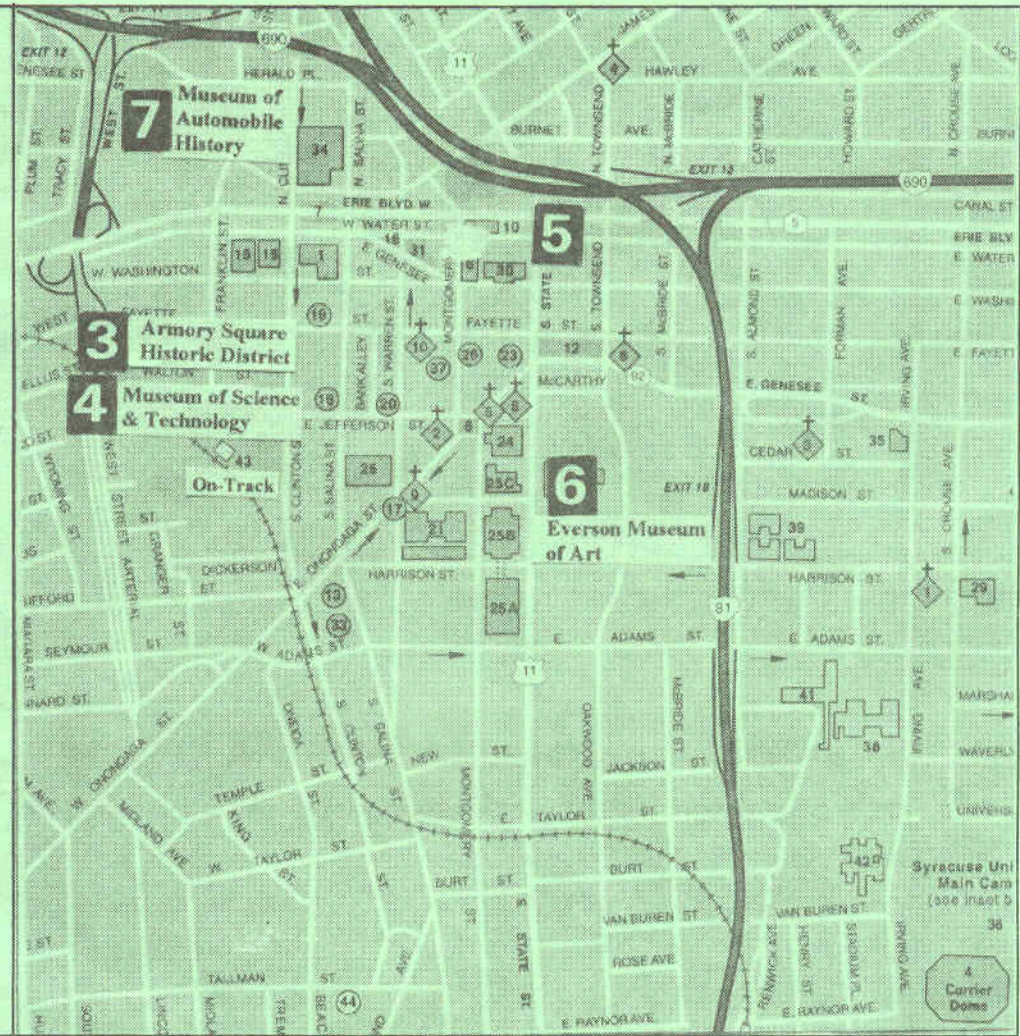
